Our activities also include creating a place or a salon where people in the community can get together, or organizing food drives by collecting surplus food from shops and families and redistributing it as needed. We provide a wide range of consultation services to support the local community.


Small introductory remarks of "INAGINA", the official mascot of Council of Social Welfare, Inagi City

The following are examples of support we can provide.

Concerns on neighbor (I)

My neighbor may have some problems. There is a lot of rubbish in his house.

The So called "8050 problem"

A family with a mother in her 80s and a son in his 50s; the mother needs care and the son is prone to illness.

Young carer issues

A student in my neighborhood looks very tired. He has to take care of his younger brothers all day long.

Withdrawal matters

My child has been withdrawn for over a decade and I don't know what to do.



Concerns on neighbor (II)

I haven't seen my neighbor recently. I worry that he is ill.



Regional support

We support community development so that people can connect and help one another.



Food donated by the community is redistributed through welfare offices.

The following are examples of support we can provide.

Public relations support

Think together about PR methods so that your local activities are better known.

Building up a social activity

If you want to set up an activity such as community salon or children's cafeteria, we will give advice as needed.



Activity continuation

We will help you continue your activities and find solutions when you face difficulties.



Information sharing

We share information about social welfare activities.

Food drive

If you are interested in starting it, we can provide information.
