

## At the Volunteer Center, we provide the following services.

### Support for volunteer activities

- Whether you want to start volunteering or need a helping hand from volunteers, we're here to listen and help coordinate.
- If you're new to volunteering or want to build your skills, we offer workshops and training sessions every year.
- We provide volunteer insurance (300 yen per year) so you can take part in activities with peace of mind.
- We publish the volunteer newsletter "Fureai Tsushin" every month.

### Welfare Education & Learning

- We provide welfare education to help children develop awareness of compassion and welfare. We lend out simulation equipment such as wheelchairs and white canes.



### A place for everyone in the community

- We support places where people in the community can meet and spend time together, such as the Fureai Center and Fureai Ikiiki Salons.

### Preparing for disaster

- A disaster volunteer center will be established and operated immediately.
